Altissimo & Throat Tones

..... Altissimo Register

..... Throat Tones

For longer durations, closing the right-hand keys on Throat Tone notes (eg. "Closed B♭") improves tone and intonation.




*When there are two notes for the same fingering, add the Register Key to play the upper note
